ARK rendered in Carrara5

King Solomon summoned into his presence at the elders of Israel, all the heads of the tribes and the chiefs of the Israelite families, to bring up the ark of the Lord's covenant.

- All the Israelites came together to King Solomon at the time of the festival in the seventh month.

### 1. Forgiveness
