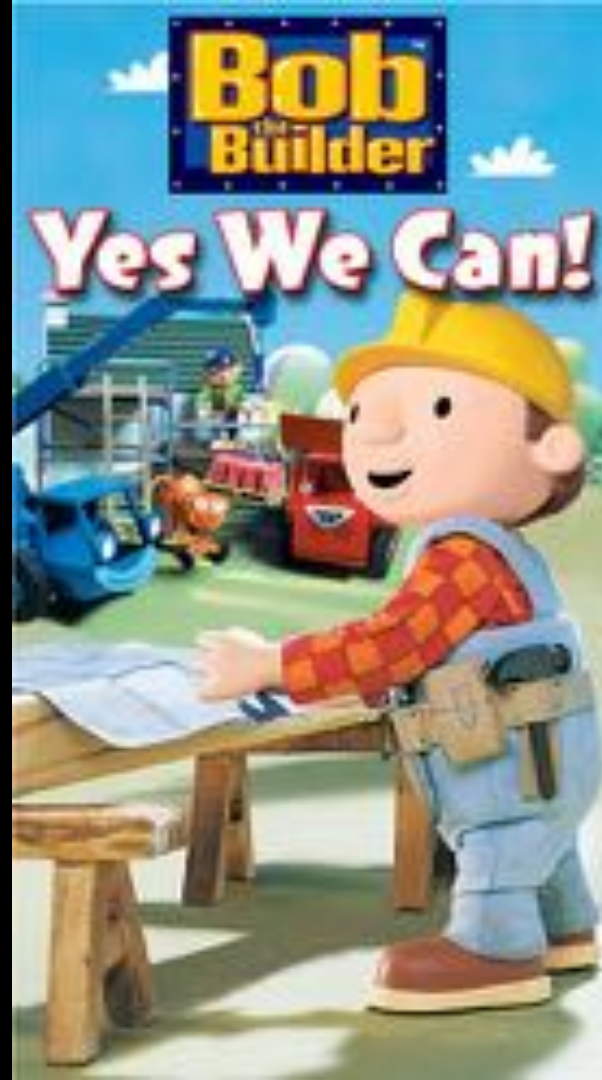

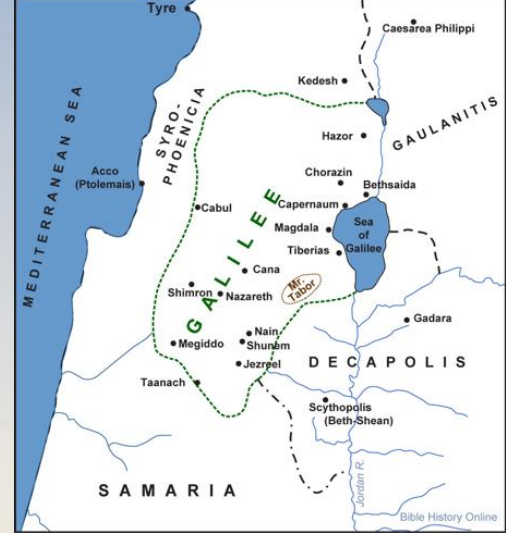

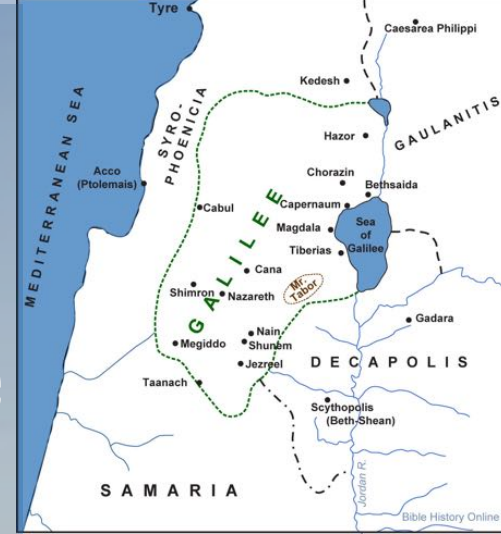
What Happened

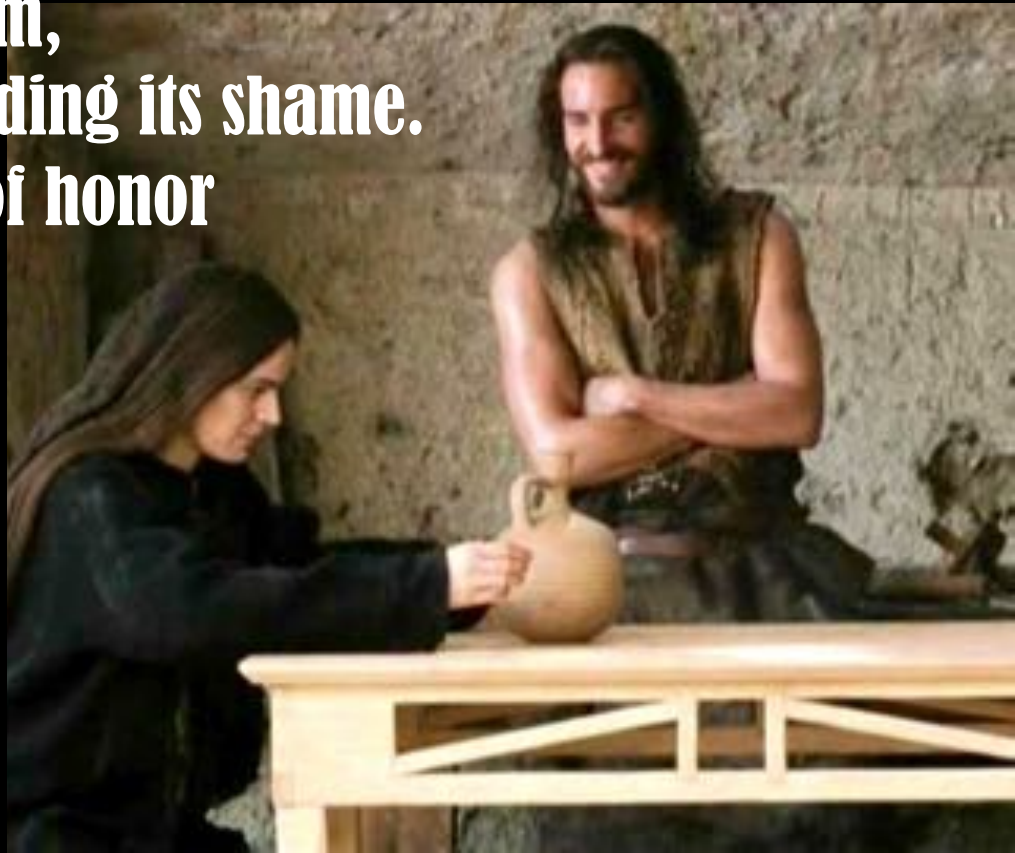

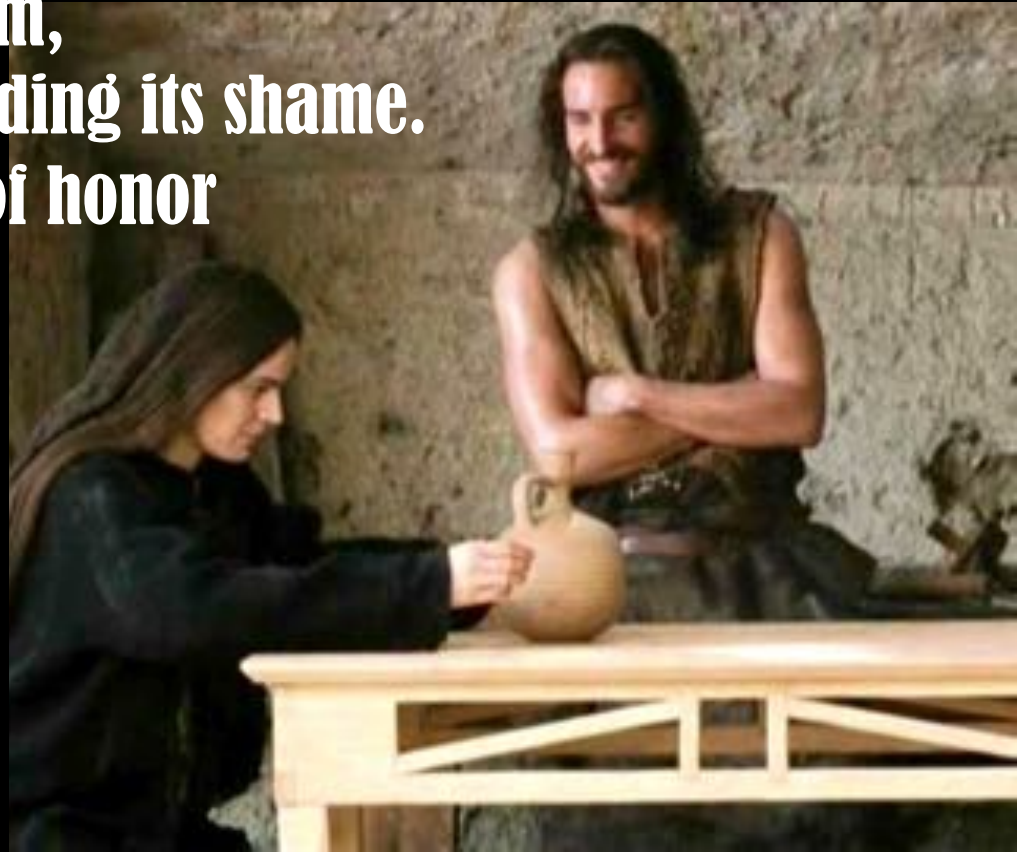

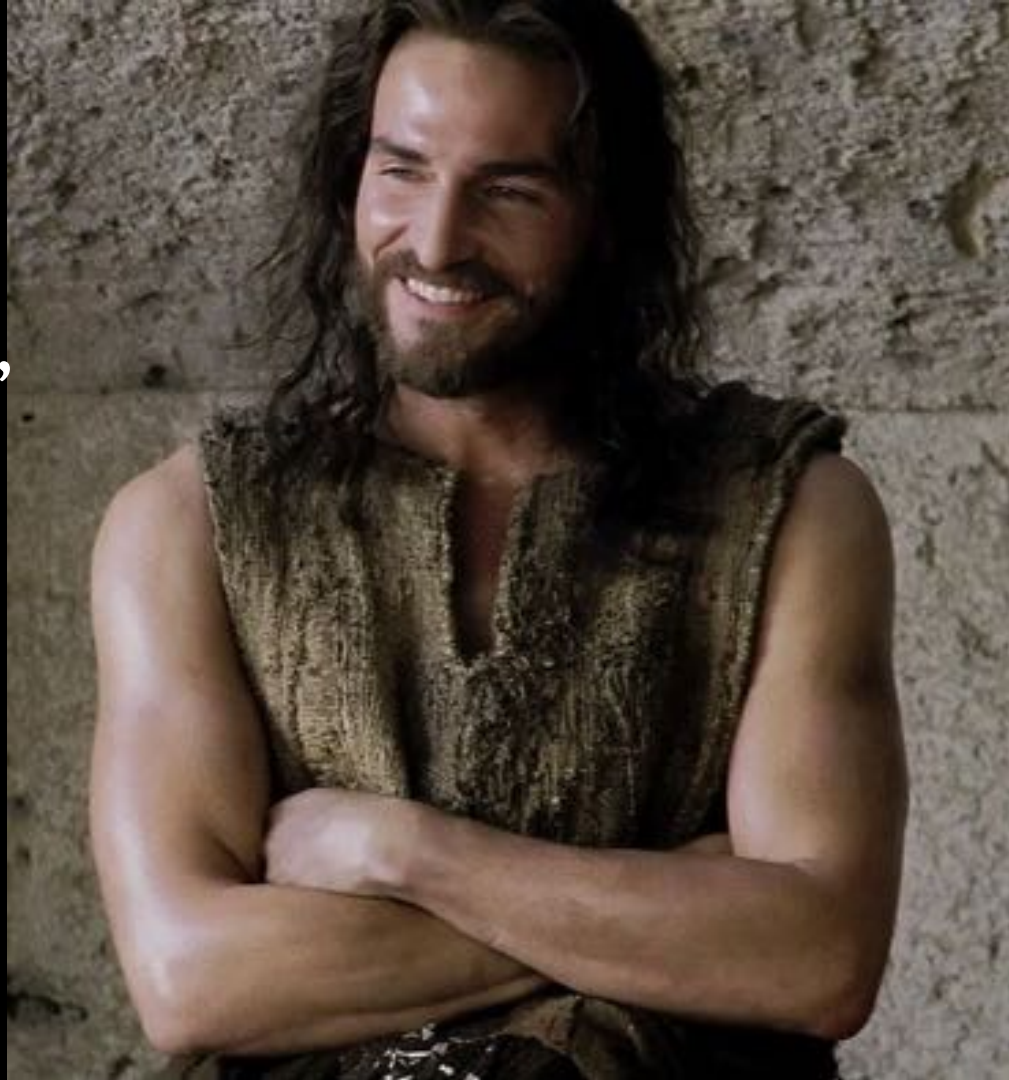
