Matt 16-18











On the day of Pentecost all the believers were meeting together in one place. Then, what looked like flames or tongues of fire appeared and settled on each of them. Acts 2: 32-33









Those who passed by hurled insults at him, shaking their heads and saying, ...come down from the cross and save yourself!"

Mark 15: 29 – 30










When the captain of the Temple guard and the leading priests heard this, they were perplexed,
